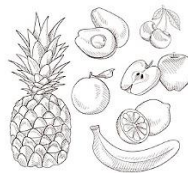

Deepfake is a smart computer technology that can change pictures and sounds to make them look and sound authentic. It uses **sophisticated programs** to learn how people talk and move their faces. This means a computer can copy someone's face and voice to create a video that looks just like them.

Deepfake can be used in many ways. In movies, it can make old actors look young again or put them in scenes without them being there. In schools, teachers can use Deepfake to show students what famous people from history looked and sounded like. Artists can use Deepfake to make fun and creative videos. Some businesses also use Deepfake to make digital helpers that can talk to customers.

However, Deepfake can also be dangerous. Some people use it to make fake news, trick others online, or steal personal information. It can also change videos to make it look like someone did something they never actually did. Because of these problems, it is important to have rules for using Deepfake safely. Some governments are making laws to stop the misuse of this powerful technology.

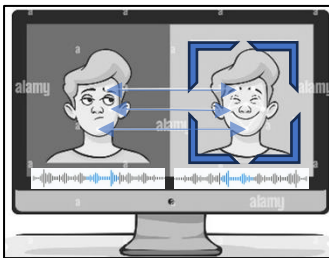

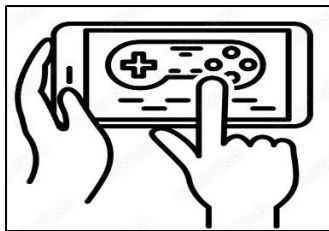
