Korea has beautiful nature, too. You can visit the mountains or beaches. Jeju Island is a famous place for its beaches and volcano. Many people go there to relax.

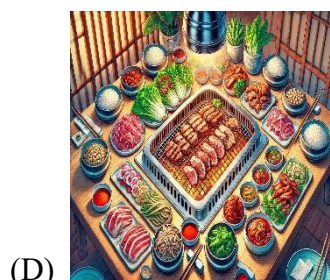
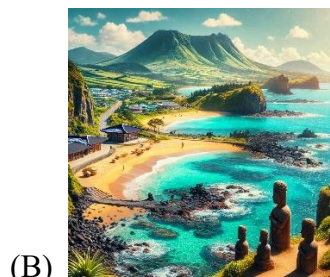
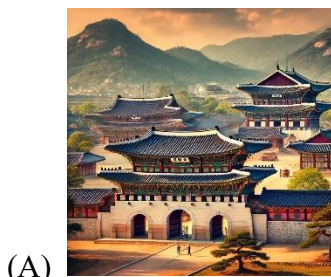
